Methodologies

This disclosure details all transfers of value made to Healthcare Professionals and Healthcare organisations in the UK and Ireland by Pharmacosmos UK and includes payments made by Pharmacosmos A/S (Global). All payments disclosed were made in 2019.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the decision was taken to include transfers of value for 2019 based on aggregate figures for all categories. Usually there would be an additional review and verification step before publication, which involves contacting all of the healthcare professionals we have worked with in this way. This step is undertaken on the basis of advice from the Information Commissioner's Office. This year it was agreed that it would not be right to contact healthcare professionals further in this way as it could add to their workload during a time when the NHS is rightly focussed on responding to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Payments to HCOs have been disclosed on an activity basis.

All disclosed data is in GBP. Where payments were converted from another currency, the calculations reflect the actual exchange rate on the date the payment was made. All amounts are inclusive of VAT where VAT has been paid.

The information declared includes transfers of value that were made and does not include any planned activities and transfers where HCPs did not for whatever reason complete.
